Inspectors' Matters, Issues and Questions for Examination Part 2 [ID19] - Clarification Note

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Further to the publication of the Inspectors' Matters, Issues and Questions for Examination – Part 2 [ID19] this note provides additional clarification on the relationship between Part 1 and Part 2 Hearings.

General

For Matters 1 – Legal and Procedural; Matter 2 – Maintaining Effective Cooperation; and Matter 3 – The Housing Target/Requirement there is no need to resubmit statements/representations made at the Part 1 Hearing stage. They are to be taken as read and we will form part of our overall assessment of these matters as the examination progresses. The purpose of the Part 2 Hearings is to take forward previous discussions on these matters and participants should, therefore, **only** respond directly to the specific questions raised in ID19 in their statements and not repeat previous representations.

Matter 4 - Employment Land Requirement

Matter 4 - Employment Land Requirement was considered in detail at the Part 1 Hearings. There will not, therefore, be a repeat of the hearing session, and we have no further questions on this matter at this juncture. As stated above, we will take into consideration the statements/representations previously submitted for Matter 4 for the Part 1 Hearings.

Participants should note, however, that Questions 3.4 and 3.5 consider the potential implications of the recalculated LHN [LPA63] for the Employment Land Needs Assessment 2024 [HES08/HES08.1] and future jobs growth.
