## Waste Reduction Initiatives Run By CAGs

Community Fridge	Community fridges take surplus food from supermarkets and other businesses and make it available for the local public. This food is usually items that have limited shelf life such as fruit and vegetables and bakery produce, though there may also be longer life items available.
	There is usually no charge for taking items (though most fridges will happily accept donations) and it is available for all.
Community Larder	Community larders take surplus food from supermarkets and other businesses and make it available for the local public. This food is usually long shelf life including canned and dried goods but is surplus stock from warehouses. Community larders are run as a membership scheme with an annual and weekly fee.
Repair Cafe	Volunteers will attempt to mend broken small household items. These can be electricals. Technology, mechanical items, fabrics or tools in need of sharpening. What each Repair Café can offer depends on the abilities of their volunteers.
Library of Things	There are many items that are bought by householders and rarely used. A library of things is a community led loan service where these items can be borrowed for a small charge.
Refill Stations	Refill stations offer environmentally friendly household cleaning products, which are purchased by refilling your old bottles and containers.
Swap Shops	Also known as Freecycle events or Give Or Take events, unwanted but usable items can be donated, with the opportunity to take other items away for free. Some events are specialist eg Swish events are clothing only
