



	a neighbourhood development plan to correct errors with the			
	permission of the Qualifying Body.

	force on 23 October 2024; and delegated to the Head of Policy and			
	Programmes, in consultation with the appropriate Cabinet Member			
	and in agreement with the Qualifying Body, Steventon Parish			
	Council, the making of minor (non-material) modifications, the			
	correction of any spelling, grammatical, typographical or factual			
	errors together with any improvements from a presentational
